Overview: The Combat Desert Jacket (CDJ) is a lightweight, wind resistant, water repellent jacket intended to provide multi-season environmental protection in desert environments.

Features: The CDJ has the following features: Five pockets with water resistant zipper closures-two chest, two lower front, and one upper sleeve; a rank tab on the left front chest; collar has a stowed balaclava (hood); lightweight four-way stretch material in the underarm and upper back panels reduces bulk and provides mobility and ventilation; sleeves have reinforced elbows, and adjustable wrist closures.
