Overview: The Extreme Cold Weather (ECW) Suit provides protection in extreme cold weather environments. It is an over garment that consists of a parka, trouser, and booties. The ECW Suit is used in bivouac, rest, and sentry duties.

Features: The ECW Suit garments are lightweight and easily packed to a minimum volume. The garments are oversized and designed with features to enable quick donning/doffing over multiple clothing layers. The shell material is highly water repellant and wind resistant. The insulation maintains uniform thickness and insulating properties after repeated packing, unpacking, and commercial launderings. The garments do not allow wind to penetrate and are quick drying.

Components: Parka, trousers, and booties
